



## Security Experts Say This Ear-Shattering Self-Defense Device Could Save Your Life One Day

On the night of January 19, 2019, Shannon Miller could have been killed.

After a party at a friend's house that night, she was walking alone to her car when she felt something many of us have felt before – the feeling of being watched.

She was in a strange neighborhood and didn't know the streets that well. When she reached her car, two men jumped out of the darkness and charged at her.

One pressed her forcefully against her car and placed a hand over her mouth, while the other began searching her pockets. When they found nothing, one of the one men started unbuttoning her jeans.

That's when Shannon said she pulled the chain of her [SafeSiren](#).



An ear-shattering alarm disrupted the muffled dark and quiet street like a shockwave. Dogs started barking, lights started turning on in several houses.

The attackers immediately let her go and bolted back to the shadows down the street.

*"They were scared shitless," Shannon remembered of her attackers that night. "If I hadn't had my [SafeSiren](#) on me, I probably wouldn't be alive today. They made it very clear what they wanted to do to me."*



## Raise Alarms, Not Fists

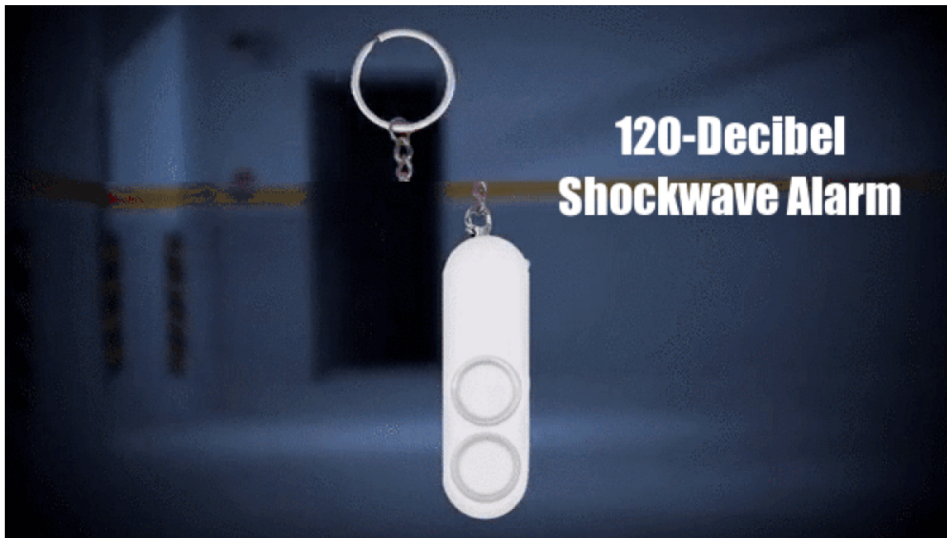
Self-defense instructor and security expert, Kevin McConnor, said that in Shannon's case, using her [SafeSiren](#) was the best call for her situation.

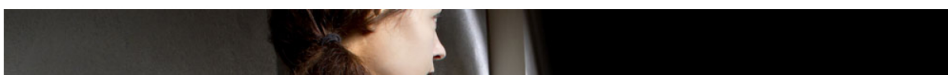


## Perfect For Any Age
